The City of San Diego appeared on June 8, 2009, at 11:00 am to show cause why this court should not issue a temporary restraining order prohibiting the City, its boards, commissions and administrators, from compelling any employee to make an election of any sort relating or referring to the City's Deferred Retirement Option Plan pending further order of this court. Daphne M. Anneet and Timothy L. Davis of Burke of Williams & Sorensen, LLP appeared on behalf of the City. Michael A. Conger appeared on behalf of the San Diego Police Officers Association and Ann M. Smith appeared on behalf of the San Diego Municipal Employees Association, as interested parties.

The court, having been fully informed by briefs submitted and argument of counsel, issued a temporary restraining order prohibiting the City of San Diego, its boards, commissions and administrators, from compelling any police officer to make an election of any sort relating or

referring to the City's Deferred Retirement Option Plan (whether provided for in memoranda of understanding, contract, City Charter or otherwise) pending further order of this court. Any election by an employee that could have been made or must have been made in the time between this restraining order and further order of this court, shall be deemed to have been made on or before the respective election date, *nunc pro tunc*.

The City ordered to return June 25, 2009, at 9:00 am in Department 67 regarding a preliminary injunction to the same effect.

NOW THEREFOR, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The City of San Diego, its pension plans, boards, commissions and administrators, are restrained from compelling any sworn officer of the San Diego Police Department to make an election of any sort relating or referring to the City's Deferred Retirement Option Plan pending hearing on a preliminary injunction on June 25, 2009. Any election by an employee that could have been made or must have been made between the date of this temporary restraining order and June 25, 2009, inclusive, shall be deemed to have been made on or before the respective election date, *nunc pro tunc*.

This temporary restraining order will expire on Thursday, June 25, 2009, at 6:00 pm or upon further order of this court, whichever occurs first.
