21	I, Jeff Jordon, declare as follows:	
22	1. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein and if called to do so could	
23	testify competently thereto.	
24	2. I am the Vice President of the San Diego Police Officers Association. The San	
25	Diego Police Officers Association ("SDPOA") is a mutual benefit corporation organized and	
26	doing business as a State of California sanctioned employee organization representing police	
27	officers holding the rank of lieutenant and below who are employed by the City of San Diego	
28	("City"). The scope of the SDPOA's representation of San Diego Police officers in negotiating	

labor-management agreements, and the City's duty to meet and confer in good faith, are set forth in the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act. (Gov. Code, §§ 3500-3510.) The SDPOA has approximately 1,820 members.

- 3. For the past several months, I have been carefully studying the effect of the cap on the amount of health insurance premium reimbursement the City will pay under San Diego Municipal Code section 24.1202(a)(8). (See the accompany Request for Judicial Notice in Support of Motion for Certification of Class, Exhibit 3.) That law, which became effective on July 1, 2009, applies to "all Safety Members in the San Diego Police Officers Association" who retire after July 1, 2009. (RJN, Exh. 3; San Diego Municipal Code, § 24.1201(a)(8)(ii).)
- 4. The City does not permit any employees, including SDPOA members, hired on or after July 1, 2005, to qualify for any insurance premium reimbursement the City will pay under San Diego Municipal Code section 24.1202(a)(8).
- 5. I have been informed that the proposed definition of the class is: "All Safety Members in the San Diego Police Officers Association who began their employment for the City of San Diego before July 1, 2005, and have retired, or will retire, after July 1, 2009."
- 6. As part of my job responsibilities for the past several weeks, I am familiar with the approximate number of SDPOA members within that proposed class definition. The class consists of approximately 1,463 persons.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.
